- Birthday Treats: Our school guideline is that treats must be commercially produced to ensure safety and lessen contamination.

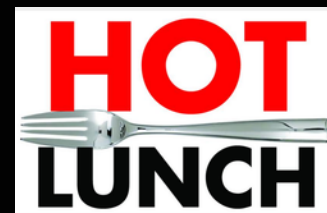

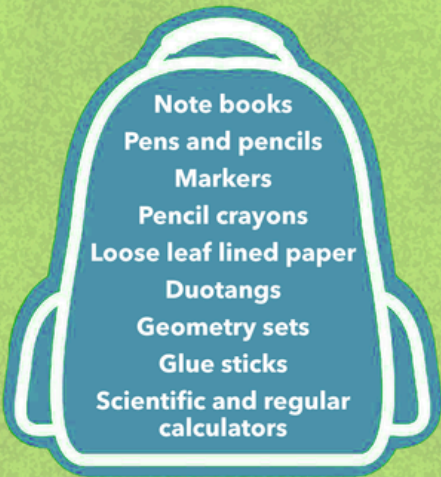
