- Birthday Treats: Our school guideline is that treats must be commercially produced to ensure safety and lessen contamination.

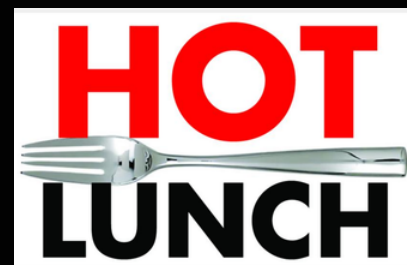

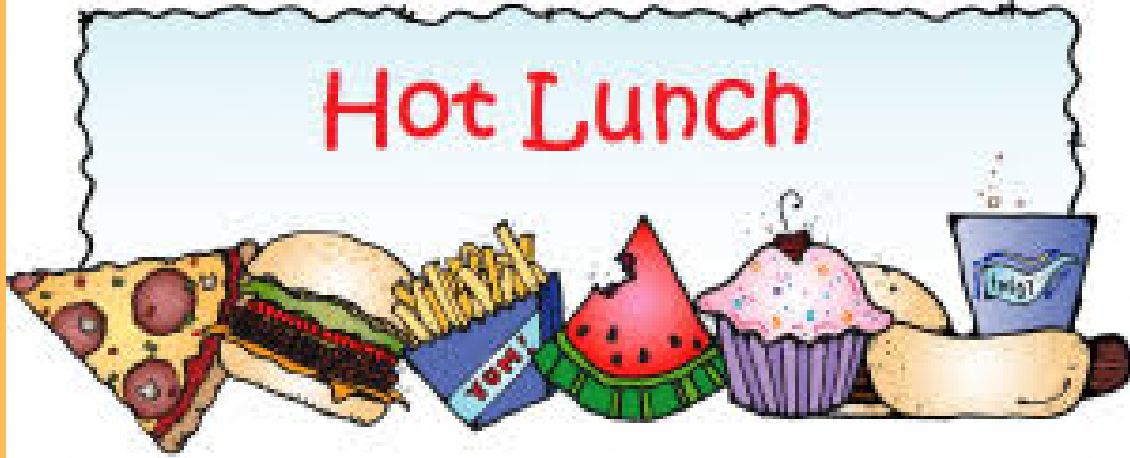
Dear Parents and Guardians,

Who is the Preschool (Early Intervention Pre-Kindergarten) program for?

- **Children must be 2 years and 8 months of age as of August 31 in the respective school year**
